Entry Forms

- Include your entry fee (limit of 2 entries per section)

Framing and Presentation

- Please ensure all artwork is framed, or finished on all sides and ready for hanging
- Each entry should have the artist’s name, title and cost securely attached to the back of each work, not the front. The associated catalogue will feature all details.
- Refer to entry form for size restrictions for each section.

Delivery of Artwork

- The Tiaro Memorial Hall 7th August, between 9am & 1pm

Collection of Unsold /Sold art work

- Must be picked up from the Tiaro Memorial Hall by 12 noon Monday 11th August 2008
- Sold works will not be released until close of the show on Sunday 10th August after 2.30pm
- All work must be signed out.

Insurance

- Insurance of artworks is the sole responsibility of the artists

Conditions of Entry to Tiaro District Arts & Craft Festival 2008

Entries

- Each entry must be the original work of the artist/craftsperson.
- All works on exhibition must clearly show name of the artist, title of work and year of creation.
- Entries close 18th July 2008. All entries must be accompanied by entry fee per work (limit 2 per section). Each artist/exhibitor will receive a complimentary invitation to Opening night (on Friday 8th August at 7pm) on delivery of artwork.
- All artworks are to remain for the full length of show.
- All cheques are payable to Tiaro Promotions Inc, Box 56, Tiaro 4650

Commission

- A commission of 10% will be deducted from all works sold.
- Artists will be paid by cheque by the end of September.
- Artists must provide account name and postal details for the prompt delivery of cheques.

Framing and Presentation

- All artworks must be suitably framed and ready for hanging or display.
- Exhibits are limited to two per section.
- The committee may refuse any work not suitably presented.

Delivery

- All artwork must be delivered to the Tiaro Memorial Hall, Mayne Street, Tiaro on 7th August between 9am & 1pm.

Collection of Art works

- All sold/unsold/not for sale artworks must be collected from the Tiaro Memorial Hall after 2.30pm Sunday 10th August and no later than 12 noon on Monday 11th August.
- Uncollected works will attract a holding fee of \$5.00 per item per day until collected. Items not collected on Sunday or Monday will need to be collected from another location. (artworks will not be stored at the Memorial Hall)
- No responsibility will be taken for any artwork not collected by this time.

Care and responsibility

- Whilst all care will be taken, Tiaro Promotions Inc will not be responsible for any loss of, or damage to, any artwork submitted for exhibition.
- Insurance of artworks is the sole responsibility of the artist.

Display of Artworks

- Any artwork may be excluded from display at the exhibition at the sole discretion of the Art Show committee without prior notification to the artist. In this case, the fee for entry will be refunded.
